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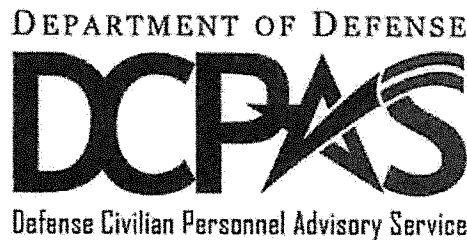


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Defense Senior Leader Development Program



The Defense Senior Leader Development Program (DSLDP) is the premier civilian leader development program for the Department of Defense. DSLDP institutes a competency-based approach to the deliberate development of senior civilian leaders with the enterprise-wide perspective needed to lead organizations and programs, and achieve results in the joint, interagency, and multi-national environments.

Who should participate?

Permanent full-time Department of the Navy (DON) Civilian employees who are already leading high performing organizations and programs and have the potential

and motivation to take on even more responsible senior leadership positions across the DoD Enterprise within the next few years. The requirements has been relaxed to admit GS-14 through GS-15 or equivalent; possess a minimum of 1 year supervisory or management experience acquired within the last 5 years (e.g. Team Leads or those who have/had supervisory authority).

What will I learn?

Leadership skills and competencies needed to excel in the 21st Century joint, interagency, and multi-national environments. Participants will learn how to foster interagency cooperation and information sharing methodologies that will prepare them to sense and respond to the issues and challenges facing leaders across DoD and the broader national security arena.

What is required of me?

To graduate from DSLDP participants must successfully complete all three Elements of the program. Professional Military Education (PME) prepares individuals to assume broader responsibility, expands their knowledge of the national security mission, strengthens their understanding of complex policy and operational challenges faced by senior DoD officials; Defense-focused Leadership Seminars that blend real-world learning and powerful, challenging experiences, providing core knowledge for an Enterprise-wide perspective and the opportunity to apply leadership skills in the increasingly complex joint and national security environments; Individual Development is for the participant to demonstrate targeted proficiencies in the critical leadership competencies.

What do I do first?

Complete your DSLDP package and submit your endorsement through your chain-of-Command.

Application packages must include the following: Nominee Information Sheet (form); Supplemental Nominee Information Sheet for DSLDP and relevant attachments (form); Resume (template - five page limit); Statement of Interest (form); ECQ Statements; DSLDP Supervisor Assessment (form); three Performance Ratings; Academic Transcript(s); Biography (template); Letter(s) of Recommendation (optional). Applicants are advised to check with their Command Training Representative for information regarding internal deadline dates and any additional requirements. Command endorsed packages must be submitted via the Portal Electronic Submission Process. Original copies are not necessary.

How does the selection process work?	... The selection process has two phases, a DON process and a DoD process. During the first phase DON conducts a selection panel and forwards approved packages to DCPAS. During the second phase the DCPAS Selection Board will review all nominations and make a recommendation

What if I already attended PME? Can I still enter the program?	... Yes. Individuals who have already attended a senior-level Joint PME may still be nominated by their component. If selected, they will be assessed individually by the Executive-level Selection Board to determine if they need a refresher.
What is the actual time I will be away from my desk?	... 10 months for training plus your individual development
What is the participant's commitment while in the program?	... Participants must balance work and quality of life with DSLDP responsibilities and appreciate that DSLDP is a challenging, demanding, yet a significantly rewarding program. They must fully engage themselves in all of the program elements to include all IDP activities.
When is the due date of the application?	... Command endorsed packages are due to the DON DSLDP Program Manager. The deadline date is 16 Aug 2019. Please check with your Command Training Representative for information regarding deadline dates and
