BASE ACCESS (NBSD) - Current Common Access Card (CAC) required. There are three (3) entry/exit points to the dry side of the 32nd Street Naval Base:


- Gate 32 on Yama Street/Division Street preferred entry point.
- Gate 43 on Norman Scott Road at 32nd Street.
- Gate 29 on Vesta Street

*Under no circumstances will any TCW staff member escort any person onto the base who fails to meet the access requirements given above.

NOTE: All vehicles must have current registration and proof of insurance available at all times (rental agreement satisfies this requirement) and are subject to random inspection by NBSD security personnel at any time.

Note: 3975 Norman Scott Road is our mailing address. Many GPS systems will get you close to our location, but will not provide accurate directions toeither of our building locations. Please reference the included maps to better locate our facilities.

The MSC-TCW office (room 205) and Classrooms 204 & 207 are located on the second floor of building 3294. (SW corner of Norman Scott Rd. and Vesta Street).


