# **MSC CIVMAR TRAINING FREQUENT ASKED QUESTIONS:**

## What is the process of requesting training?

<u>Assigned onboard:</u> All Training Request Forms must be vetted via CIVMARS' chain of command onboard for approval before submitting requests to the MSC Training Specialists for consideration.

<u>Not assigned onboard:</u> CIVMARS that aren't assigned to a an MSC ship, must submit their Training Requests Forms via the designated MSC Placement Specialists (Detailers) and the MSC Training Specialists for consideration.

# Can I arrange, pay and attend training courses and ask for reimbursement after I complete training?

No, as per SECNAVINST 12410.25B, 4. Funding Training Expenses, it states, "Employees must obtain prior approval before incurring any expenses for which they are requesting reimbursement from the command." CIVMARS that arrange and pay for training are <a href="MOT">MOT</a> authorized reimbursement from MSC for any classes including any required STCW Training courses.
